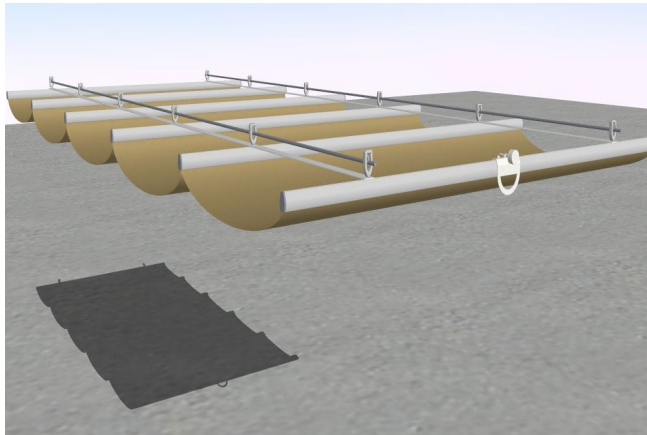


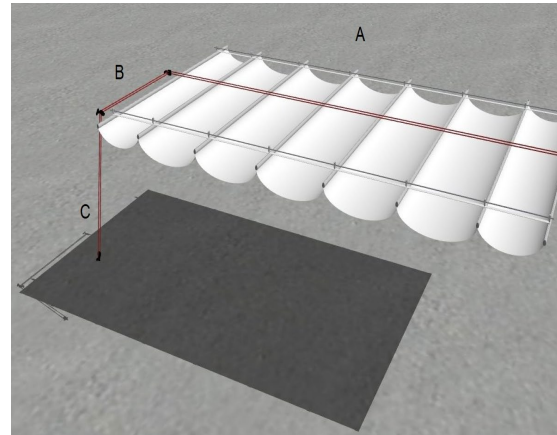
Infinity Canopy

Opening/Closing Mechanism Options

Mechanism	Pros	Cons	Cost
Limit Tape	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can hold the canopy in a fully extended position. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cannot hold the canopy in partially extended or fully retracted positions. Requires using a stool to fasten and unfasten the canopy to the pergola. Tape hanging not attractive to some. 	\$0
Four-foot pole and magnetic latch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can hold the canopy in a fully extended position using a pole. No need to use a stool. No tape hanging from edge of canopy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cannot hold the canopy in partially extended or fully retracted positions. Will not hold long canopies e.g. 20ft 	\$65 per latch. Sections require at least one, but wider and longer canopies require 2 or 3 latches.
Pulley system	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will hold the canopy in all positions, including fully extended, partially extended, and fully retracted. No need to use a stool. No tape hanging from edge of canopy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ropes visible overhead when canopy is in the retracted position. 	\$65 per pulley. One pulley system is required per section regardless of dimensions.
